
Red Hill Shaft & Navy Aiea-Halawa Shaft Reactivation



Long Term Reactivation of Red Hill Shaft








Tank Cleaning

- ☐ Step 1 Preparation (Approx. 2-3 months):
 - · Isolate tank and disconnect piping
 - · Install tank ventilation equipment and inject water to soften sludge
 - · Remove flowable sludge
 - · Begin tank ventilation with forced air
- ☐ Step 2 Remove Solid Sludge (Approx. 2-3 months):
 - · Inspect and repair central tower and catwalk
 - Install center tower elevator; load test tower and catwalk
 - · Remove solid sludge
- ☐ Step 3 Pressure Washing (Approx. 1-2 months):
 - · Set up pressure washing system and
 - Pressure wash with 3% Simple Green
 - · Rinse, continuously removing rinsate
 - · Dry tank interior and validate cleanliness; submit cleaning report
 - Receive regulatory agency final approval that tank is clean
- ☐ Step 4 Tank Decommission (Approx. 1-2 Months):
 - · Remove booms and infrastructure
 - Install permanent lockable steel hatch at the entrance

JBPHH Drinking Water System Flushing

Dec. 2021 - Mar. 2022

- Complete flush of the JBPHH distribution system including all facilities and residences.
- DOH lifted health advisory, Mar. 2022: certified system as safe.

Drinking Water Long Term Monitoring

Mar. 2022 - Mar. 2024

- 24-month monitoring of the JBPHH drinking water.
- 9,200+ samples.
- 50+ analytes metals, hydrocarbons, Synthetic Organic Compounds, and Volatile Organic Compounds.
- Repeated sampling of source and schools.
- 19 zones.

Extended Drinking Water Monitoring

Apr. 2024 - Mar. 2025

- Navy voluntarily implemented: approved by EPA.
- 6,200+ samples.
- 50+ analytes.
- Expanded fuel indicator compounds.
- · New zone in Manana.
- Higher frequencies of priority areas.

Submit Closeout Report to Regulators

Compliance Monitoring

- Recurring monitoring in accordance with the Safe Drinking Water Act for drinking water systems.
- Full drinking water analytes sampled for, plus required operational testing (bacteria/chlorine/etc).
- Reported to all consumers by the JBPHH consumer confidence report which is completed each summer.





Began site assessment of Red Hill facility with research and preliminary sampling.




Monitored air quality during fuel tank cleaning ventilation.

Ongoing Hālawa Stream ecological monitoring.




