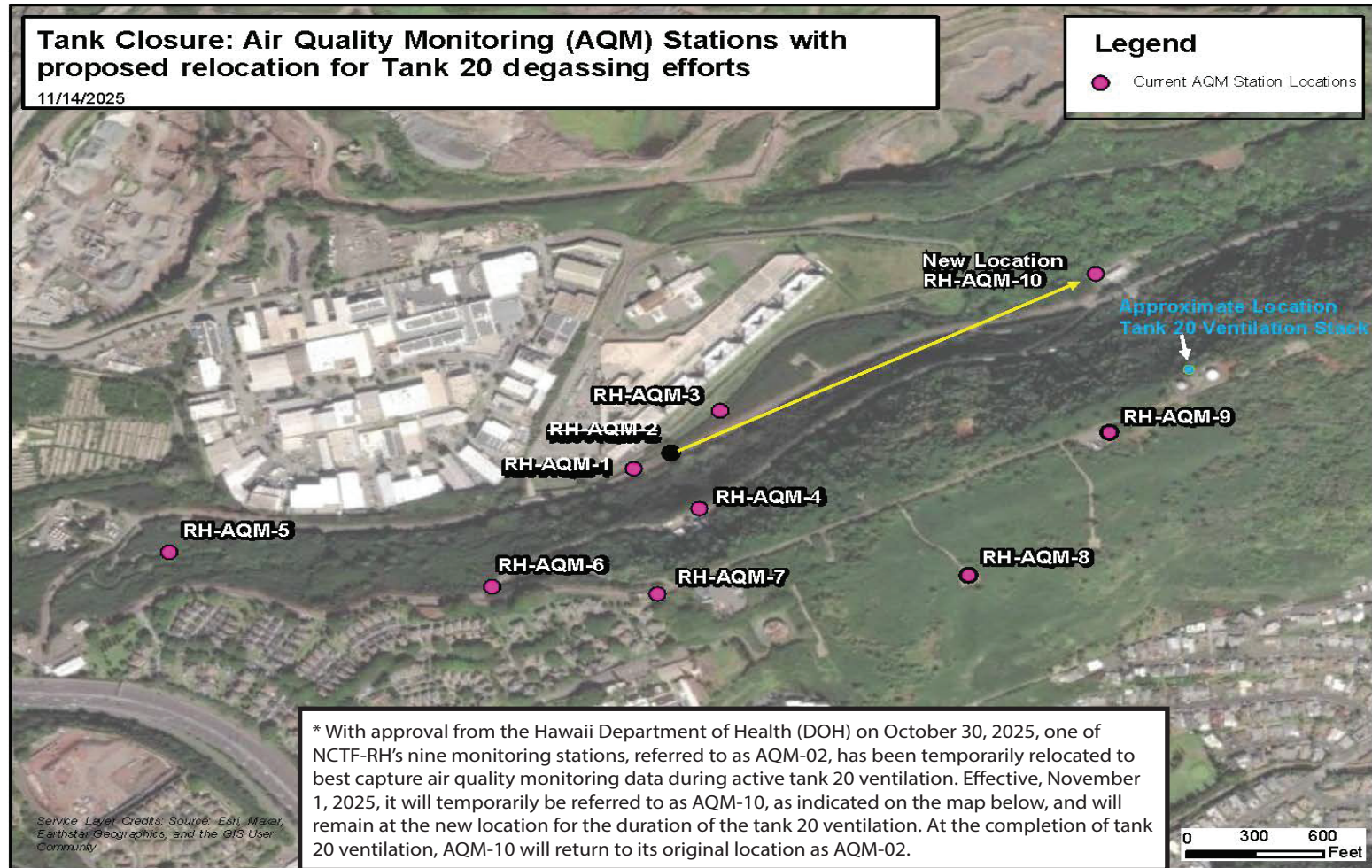


Tank Closure: Air Quality Monitoring (AQM) Stations with proposed relocation for Tank 20 degassing efforts

* With approval from the Hawaii Department of Health (DOH) on October 30, 2025, one of NCTF-RH's nine monitoring stations, referred to as AQM-02, has been temporarily relocated to best capture air quality monitoring data during active tank 20 ventilation. Effective, November 1, 2025, it will temporarily be referred to as AQM-10, as indicated on the map below, and will remain at the new location for the duration of the tank 20 ventilation. At the completion of tank 20 ventilation, AQM-10 will return to its original location as AQM-02.
