SLUDGE REMOVAL



The mission of Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill (NCTF-RH) is to execute the permanent decommissioning of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF) safely and expeditiously, and continue long-term environmental remediation in coordination with State and Federal regulators in order to protect public health and the environment.

Working at the speed of safety

Workers will safely descend to the bottom of the tank in a suspension basket to shovel sludge into 5-gallon buckets.

Five-gallon buckets will be lifted in suspension baskets and moved outside of the tank. Workers will transfer the sludge to a 55-gallon drum positioned in a secondary containment.

Drums will be sealed at approximately 3/4
full and inspected by a site supervisor to ensure it is properly sealed.

 Sludge will be shipped off island for disposal.
