

# Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility CLOSURE PROCESS

The mission of Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill (NCTF-RH) is to execute the permanent decommissioning of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF) safely and expeditiously, and continue long-term environmental remediation in coordination with State and Federal regulators in order to protect public health and the environment.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL LINE OF EFFORT**

- Spill Prevention and Preparedness.
- Protection of air, water, and land resources through regulatory compliance oversight and the use of best management practices.
- Perform site assessment as part of permanent closure.





**CLOSURE** 

- Clean and render all tanks unusable for fuel storage. Prepare facility for longterm environmental monitoring.
  - Conduct an assessment plan for deconstruction and management of pipelines with removal of other infrastructure including electrical, fire protection, structural, waste water and other equipment in the facility.
  - Removal & management of waste generated during cleaning of each tank.
  - Decommissioning requires regulator inspections & approval for site closure.



#### REMEDIATION LINE OF EFFORT

- The Environmental Protection Agency and Hawaii Department of Health will conduct inspections & approval for site closure.
  - Recovery and Restoration of the Red Hill Drinking Water Shaft.
  - Extended monitoring of the Red Hill site (Navy will continue monitoring post tank cleaning & ventilation).
