NCTF-RH Completes Tank 16 Degassing

Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill safely completed tank 16 degassing operations last week and is preparing the tank for pressure washing in the coming weeks.

Air quality monitoring continued throughout degassing operations, and data was posted hourly on the mobile app and daily on the NCTF-RH website at www.navyclosuretaskforce.navy.mil.

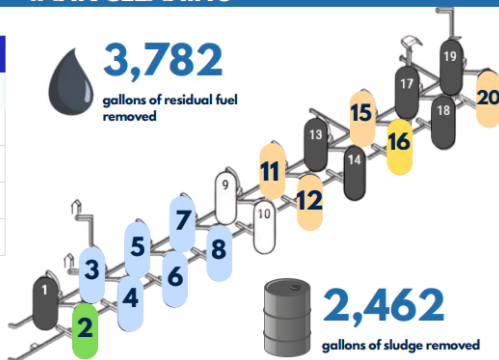

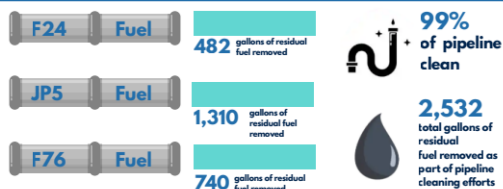

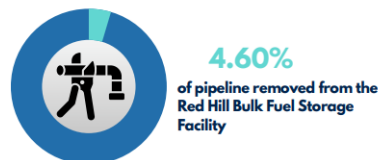
