The mission of Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill (NCTF-RH) is to execute the permanent decommissioning of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF) safely and expeditiously, and continue long-term environmental remediation in coordination with State and Federal regulators in order to protect public health and the environment.

FACT CHECK: Upon reactivation of the Navy Aiea-Halawa Shaft, the well will only supply the Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam drinking water system.

NCTF-RH Leaders Provided an Operational Update to the Hawaii House Special Committee



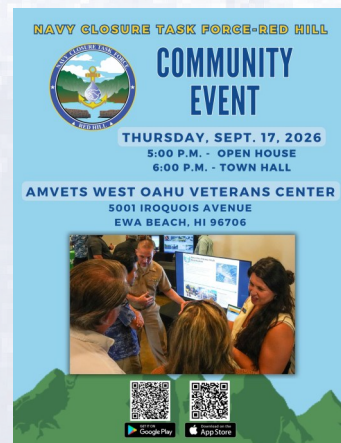
